**QUOTA** –Our entire budget for the program is provided through student fund-raising, concession stand profit, and events. The Mifflin County School District provides busing for the marching band. The quota this year is \$200 (\$300 for two band member families, meaning that each band member is asked to raise that money in donations for the concession stand and fundraising. Donations of soda (Pepsi, Diet Pepsi, Mt. Dew, Sierra Mist) in 12-ounce bottles only, and AquaFina Water-16.9 oz. bottles, hot dogs, baked goods (individually wrapped), home made soup (in crock pot), and condiments are just some of the items which we need. One of the officers is available at each practice to accept donations. If you are donating baked goods or soup, please deliver to the concession stand prior to the game on Friday evening. Make sure that you keep your receipts and attach them to a quota sheet before submitting to Miss Singley or any officer.

A tally sheet will be posted on Miss Singley's door in the band room, which students and parents can periodically check for quota totals. After a student reaches quota, money is placed into his or her spring band trip account.



**Parent Volunteers Needed:** The booster club operates two food stands at each home football game and we need help to operate these stands. You can also volunteer to sell or take tickets at the home games (our organization is paid by the district for this service).
